OPENING:

DESCRIPTION:

- Sports instruction in the Upper School for students in grades 5 through 12
- Prepares and implements sports classes to achieve learning goals set forth by both the German curriculum and the Maryland standards.
- Establishes clear objectives for all lessons, units, and projects, and communicates those objectives to students.
- Administers, tests and assignments to evaluate students' progress and grades report cards
- Maintains accurate and complete student records as required by laws, district policies, and administrative regulations.
- Observes and evaluates students' performance, behavior, social development, and physical health.
- Enforces all administration policies and rules governing students.
- Instructs and monitors students in the use and care of equipment and materials
- Prepares for assigned classes, and provides written evidence of preparation upon request by immediate supervisor(s).
- Coordinates classes with other teachers and the head of the department
- Confers with parents or guardians, other teachers, counselors, and administrators in order to resolve students' behavioral and academic problems.
- Attends professional meetings, educational conferences and workshops in order to maintain and improve professional competence; serves on committees as required
- Prepares reports on students and activities as required by the school administration.
- Advises parents and/or legal guardians of student progress for the purpose of communicating expectations and achievements, developing methods for improvement, and/or reinforcing classroom goals in the home environment
- Reports incidents (e.g. fights, suspected child abuse, suspected substance abuse, harassment, zero tolerance offenses etc.) for the purpose of maintaining personal safety of students, providing a positive learning environment and adhering to state law, board policies, and appropriate personnel guidelines
- Performs other duties, as assigned
- Ability to work in a team, displays initiative, energy and enthusiasm
